Parents received the Emergency/Student information form via backpacks. Students returning all three signed forms by Thursday, September 1, will receive free dress on Friday, September 9.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS AT SACRED HEART. Are you interested in becoming Catholic or learning more about the Catholic faith? RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) will begin this year at Sacred Heart on Sunday, September 11. The program is intended to help non-Catholics interested in learning about Catholicism through the use of presentations and discussions on core teachings of the Church. RCIA meets in the Parish Hall for two hours each Sunday, 9 until 11 a.m., and invites participants to explore the Faith in a friendly, supportive atmosphere. Though the program is focused on those interested in becoming Catholic, it can also be helpful for persons returning to the Faith after a long time away, and for those cradle Catholics who want a basic refresher in Catholic essentials.
