If you have children in multiple grade levels, please email Mrs. McClay, [lmcclay@sacredheartbr.com](mailto:lmcclay@sacredheartbr.com), to let her know which child's teacher should receive all of the materials. For example, if you have a 3<sup>rd</sup> grader and a 6<sup>th</sup> grader, you need to email Mrs. McClay and tell her if both supply bags should be in the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade group (10:30-11:00) or the 6<sup>th</sup> grade group (11:15-11:45). Materials will be packed into brown bags and labeled with your child's name.

We will be collecting textbooks, library books, athletic uniforms, borrowed tech equipment, and any other items that belong to the school or classroom. Students WILL be allowed to keep consumable texts, except for Religion books, to be used for summer enrichment. We will also be collecting non-perishable food items for our St. Vincent de Paul Food Bank, so please check your pantry for anything you can donate.

The gates will be open at 9:00. The carpool line will come into the yard and follow a counterclockwise path in front of the gym and then the main building. Please be sure that you arrive during your assigned time to expedite the process. Faculty and staff will be delivering supplies from the front doors of the main building; however, in the event of inclement weather, there may be changes to this plan.
