The Diocese of Baton Rouge strives to assist families with the opportunity for providing a Catholic school education for their children through various funding streams.


Tuition assistance may be available to both Catholic and non-Catholic families through state tuition programs or through funds coordinated by the Diocese of Baton Rouge Catholic Schools Office.

The information provided below can help parents understand the process for applying for tuition assistance. Application for assistance is not a guarantee that assistance will be provided.

All required information must be submitted timely by parents, and a free-reduced lunch application must be completed to be considered for tuition assistance.

To ensure quality communication for individual situations, parents must communicate directly with the school principal on all matters regarding tuition assistance.


Below is the timeline for the tuition assistance process for first-time applicants:
