



#### Mandatory Vision Screening for Grades Pre-K 3, PreK 4, K, 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th Grade-Even if You Have an Eye Doctor Consent Forms are Due Now

Good vision plays an important role in your child's education. For that reason, students in Louisiana are required to receive vision screening at achool in Pre-K, Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7º grade. All other grades participation are optional. Many childhood eye problems can be improved if identified and treated before age eight.

This is our 4th year, partnering with the Lion's Club as they streen our students using the Plusoptix streener. Their Cub Sight Program is available this year (for bids under 6) and their new Sight for Kids Program (for bids over 6). Advantages of the Plusoptics screener include greater reliability than manual screening in a fraction of the time. The Plusoptic screener uses infrared light that is totally harmless to the child's eyes. Screening is performed one meter away from the child in less than one second. The student's face covering remains on during screening. This device provides simultaneous measurement of both eyes (binocular). Screening dues not rely on the student's shiftly to concentrate on the screening, respond to screening questions or have dilated eyes. This also creates a socially distant acceptable method of screening that is a very low risk to our students.

This is a mandatory screening for student in Pre-K, Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7° grade. Because the Lion's Club is not a part of regular Secret Heart Faculty and Staff, a signed consent must be filled out and refurmed to school before the screening. Please fill out the consent form attached. Secret Heart staff always monitors the screening. The screening will occur later this month. Please return your student's consent form no later than Wednesday, September 21°. If you object to this occessing, please notify me in writing via e-mail @gpearson@eacrethearttr.com.

#### Screening Results

Plumptix Vision Screening devices provide reliable measurement values of: Full retraction recording, i.e., sphere, cylinder, and axis for follow-up examination

Pupil diameter and pupil distance

Symmetry of corneal refleces

With these measurement values it is possible to detect e.g., following most prevalent childhood vision disorders that may lead to the development of ambiyopia (lazy eye), Hyperopia (lazightedness), Myopia, (nearsightedness), Astignatism (blumed vision), Anisometropia (unequal refractive power),

Anisocoria (unequal pupil size), Strabismus (Eye misalignment) and Media opacities (e.g. cataracts or comeal scars)




