



## Medical Causes of Concentration Difficulty

If a student presents to the nurse's station with fever, vomiting, diarrhea or contagious illness, they must be picked up from school. What about the students who are having a medical issue that are not required to be excluded from school? There are so many physical and psychological reasons that also disrupt the student's day and their ability to concentrate and give their best effort at school.

I have called many parents over the last nine years of working with students to report illnesses that do not require students being excluded from school. No matter how many times I here this one comment from parents, I am always bewildered. "Have they taken their test yet? I'll pick them up after their test." I will ask the student if they feel they can concentrate enough to take that test. The answer is mostly no. How did I know to ask this? From years of nunsing and reading research. I know this student is suffering from Concentration Difficulty Disorder.

## What is Concentration Difficulty Disorder?

Concentration difficulty is a decreased ability to focus your thoughts on something. In this case of student illness, that "something" is schoolwork or a test. Concentration difficulties can be related to many things, but even a minor medical illness can cause it.

# Several large-scale research projects noted that concentration difficulty can affect a student's test score by an average of 10%.

## Think about your child's normal school performance. How does a 10-point lower grade sound?

Here are the most common causes that produce of short-term and long-term concentration difficulties you may not have thought of:

Acute (sudden short term) linesses	Chronic (remains over time or long term),
Abdominal Pain	Asthma
Allergies and Hay Fever	Concussions.
Change In Sleep Patterns	Sleep Apnea (Pauses in Breathing During Sleep)
Changes In Mood, Personality or Behavior	Vision Disorders
Difficult Menstruation	Anxiety, Depression, Bipolar Disorder
Enlarged Lymph Nodes	Emotional Trauma
Fatigue	Stress.
Feeling Very Thirsty	Medication Side Effects
Frequent Urination	Metabolic Disorders and Certain Vitamin Deficiencies
Headache	Seizure Disorders
Infections	Learning Disabilities
Migraines	
Nausea With or Without Vomiting	
Rash	
Stiff or Rigid Neck	

Correcting concentration difficulty means correcting short term illness or controlling chronic illnesses. We all want our children to be the best they can be. The body, mind and spirit all must be well to be our best selves.


