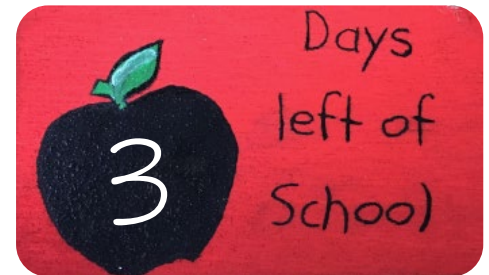

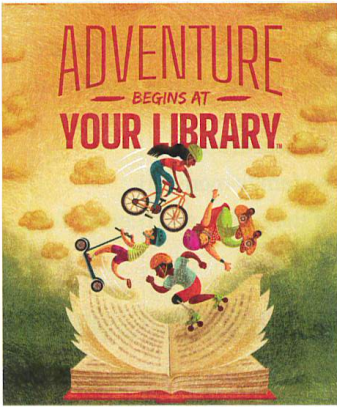

It's the H Word!

Happy Summer! It is hard to believe that the school year is over and even harder to believe that June 1st is the beginning of hurricane season!

I just got my updated instruction and training notice for hurricane season since I am a part of the emergency disaster team for Louisiana. Here are some things you may want to do while the kids are away at camp!

- **Create a Family Disaster Plan:** Ensure all family members are aware of whom to contact and where to meet in case of an emergency. Share and familiarize everyone with the plan and emergency contact numbers.
- **Key Numbers:** Prioritize communication by noting down essential numbers, including those of family members and service providers. Safeguard these numbers outside of your regular contacts list in case of phone loss, damage, or prolonged power outages.
- **Prepare a Go-Bag:** Assemble a Go-Bag containing food, water, personal essentials, COVID-19 supplies, medications, electronics, and cash. Store it in an easily accessible location like a front hall closet or garage for quick retrieval during an evacuation.
- **Inventory Your Belongings:** Document your possessions before a disaster strikes to facilitate insurance claims. Capture detailed videos or photos of each room in your home to create a comprehensive inventory.
- **Protect Important Documents:** Safeguard vital documents to streamline the recovery process post-disaster. Store physical copies in sealed plastic bags, create digital backups in cloud storage, and exchange duplicates with trusted friends or family members residing outside the affected area.
- **Pet/Service Animal Preparedness:** Your family's pet/service animal disaster preparedness kit should include an animal carrier, First Aid supplies, leashes, bowls, sanitation materials, chew toys and food, meds, and water.

Medication Pick Up 2023-2024 School Year

Medication pick up for the end of the year will begin:

- 9 am till 1 pm Tuesday through Thursday this week
- 9 am-11 am on Friday (the last day of school.)
- Please plan to pick up your child's medication.
- Your child cannot bring medications home with them.
- Medication cannot be left in the nurse's station during the summer.
- Any medications left after noon on the last day of school will be destroyed.

Planning for Medication Administration in the 2024-2025 School Year

Please help me comply with State Laws regarding medications.

1. Medication administration forms, food allergy certifications, and emergency plans for your child's specific illness will be available on Sacred Heart's website by July 1, 2024. These forms must be received by me by July 31, 2024.
2. Parents of new students and students with changes in medication must schedule an appointment to review medications, medication forms and allergies with the nurse from August 1st till August 7th. Early and late appointment options will be available.
3. Any medication appointment request after the first day of school will be scheduled for the second week of school during regular office hours.
4. Your child will not be able to have medications left at school until a completed medication packet has been received and at least one parent/guardian has met with the nurse.
5. No medications will be received on the first day of school.

Please call me at school if you have any questions. It is an honor and privilege to care for your children. By the grace of God, we will see each other in August. Have a great Summer! You will be in my prayers.
