- Provide budgetary resources to meet the needs of classroom instruction | 2025-2026 in conjunction with Finance Committee
- Support professional development opportunities for faculty in conjunction with curriculum and programming

- Address the addition of personnel to meet the demands of a growing population | Ongoing
- Provide training for technology use for teachers and students | Ongoing

- Formalize a model to provide tuition assistance for teachers' children who attend Sacred Heart School | Fall

- Enhance and expand fundraising strategies and development initiatives within the Development Department, in collaboration with the Principal, to alleviate the pressures of rising tuition costs | Ongoing
- Explore the possibility of launching a Capital Campaign to address the physical needs of the campus | 2029-2030

#### **ACTION STEPS**

- Create a School Master Plan Committee to recommend projects to be considered by the Pastor | Fall 2027
- Engage the services of an architectural firm to explore current and future facility needs related to increased school enrollment and programming in preparation for a Capital Campaign | Fall 2028
- Establish a grounds and maintenance plan with budgetary support | Fall 2029

- Create and further communicate a strong school narrative within the immediate and greater Sacred Heart School community in order to build partnerships, raise school awareness | Ongoing
- A timeline for action steps will be established and communicated to ensure effective tracking of progress and accountability in the years leading up to the 100th anniversary celebration | Summer 2025
